- I. Elms Tennis Court

- II. Allotments

- IV. All Saints' Church Yard

Rubber surface now installed. Some bark to be used for All Saints' some needs dispersing.
- VII. Portwell
Bench cleaned awaiting dry weather to apply protective coating
- VIII. Telephone Boxes
Book swap still operating well. Will change use in the spring. Canada Lane to be a school uniform swap in spring.
- IX. Willes Close Triangle
Update received that charitable status has been applied for with result expected February. Grants being sought from the VoWHDC with a focus on sports participation for the elderly.

All Saints' Church Yard

Members received and considered a letter from All Saints' regarding the upkeep of the wall at the rear of the church yard.
