- c) Members received an update on plans to save the Children's Centre which highlighted:
  - Business now plan complete
  - Bid for transitional funding has been submitted to cover 50% salaries for 3 years
  - Communities fund to apply for before 17<sup>th</sup> Jan
  - £5,800 of outside funding had been pledged
  - A charity will be set up to manage the service and raise funds for operating costs
