Temporary Closure of Roads FARINGDON NO.43 ORDER 2018

Further to your application, a Temporary Road Closure Order has been made under the provisions of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 in respect of the above event. A copy of the Order and accompanying notice is attached.

I should be grateful if you would arrange for copies of the notice to be displayed along the route of the closure prior to the event. You should keep the road closure(s) within the times specified on the order as the arrangements of other organisations rely on these timings.

In addition, you are required to ensure that the closure and any diversions are properly signed in accordance with advice contained in Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual and the requirements of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994. In this respect you may wish to contact the Highway Authority on 0845 310 1111.

Once the event is over, it is your responsibility to remove any event-related signage.

The Police have received a copy of the Order. However, it would be advisable to liaise with your local Police Station prior to the event to check their requirements.

WHEREAS the Vale of White Horse District Council is satisfied that, on the occasion of the Heritage Day the following roads named below are likely to be thronged or are liable to be obstructed:

- Bus Lane from its junction with London Street to its junction with Church Street

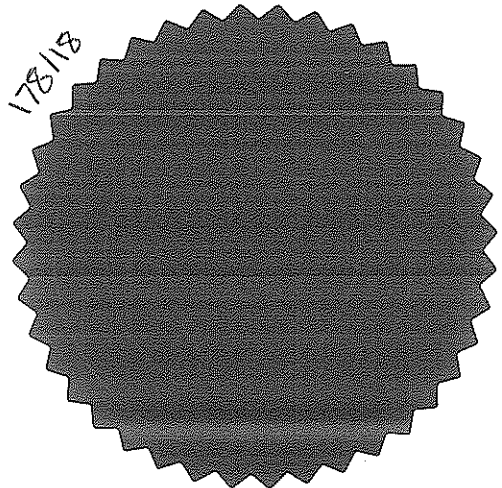
NOW THEREFORE the Vale of White Horse District Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, hereby makes the following Order:-

- (1) Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, between the hours of 8.00 and 17:00 on 15 September 2018, the streets as detailed above shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.
- (2) The restriction referred to in Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to emergency service vehicles and shall be subject to the discretion of a Police Officer in uniform.
- (3) This Order may be cited as "The Vale of White Horse District Council (Temporary Closure of Roads, FARINGDON No.43) Order 2018".
