11/5/19	<p>Neighbourhood Plans in Oxfordshire – Oxfordshire 2050</p> <p>Cllr Dr Mike Wise gave a comprehensive report on the outcome of a meeting he had attended on 11 May with representatives from other towns and parishes which, like Town Council, had "made" Neighbourhood Plans. As a result of this meeting it had been agreed that a formal body be set up in order to take matters forward and have influence on the new joint statutory spatial plan "Oxfordshire 2050". It was agreed that Cllr Dr Wise should continue as the Town Council's representative in this matter.</p>
