<b>5/2/18</b>	<b>Youth Services Review</b> Members received and considered a recommendation from the Community and Partnerships Committee. It was PROPOSED that Faringdon Town Council cease youth services in the current format and facilitate services that involve assisting other organisations to provide alternative provision that meets the needs of young people in our town. This was SECONDED and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED.  It was further PROPOSED that Faringdon Town Council cease the current service with immediate effect. This was SECONDED and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED.
<b>6/2/18</b>	<b>Pop up Nationwide Branch</b> Members NOTED a proposal to hold a pop up branch of Nationwide Building

	<p>Society in the Pump House. Nationwide proposes to hold a pop up branch in the June Rennie room once a week initially to gauge interest in a Faringdon branch. It is hoped if interest is sufficient this will lead to a Faringdon branch in the future. There is considerable concern for the town once Lloyds close and members felt this was a positive development. Concerns were raised about the potential security risks and this would need serious consideration. It was PROPOSED, SECONDED and RESOLVED and that Faringdon Town Council go ahead with accommodating the pop up branch on a weekly basis.</p>
