LOCATION: Faringdon, Gravel Walk between Letchlade Road and

**Station Road Roundabouts** 

REASON: to facilitate carriageway patching works

**DURATION:** Starting on 28 May 2019

The anticipated completion date is 31 May 2019 (date

included). This is a 24 hour per day closure.

(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5

consecutive days.)

ACCESS: limited access will be maintained for emergency service

vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of

road, subject to the progress of the works

The "No Waiting" restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow "No Waiting" cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:via Gloucester Street and Marlborough Street or alternatively B4019-Roundhills Mead-A361-A417 and vice versa
