Members: The Committee will consist of eight members including, ex officio, the Mayor and Deputy Mayor

Quorum: 3

Terms of Reference

Adopted by Council: 13/05/2024

- 1. The Committee will meet a minimum of four times per year.
- 2. The Committee will set an annual budget for consideration by the Finance and Audit Committee and monitor its financial performance against the budget previously agreed by the Council.
- 3. The Committee will be responsible for managing and maintaining the following venues
 - a. The Corn Exchange
 - b. The Pump House
- 4. The Committee will be responsible for setting fees and charges to maximize income whilst maintaining the venues as community facilities.
- 5. The Committee will be responsible for agreeing and reviewing terms and conditions of hire of the above venues.
- 6. The Committee will maintain their partnership with the Allotment Society to ensure their obligations are met and the continuous maintenance of the allotments.
- 7. The Committee will be responsible for managing and maintaining the following public open spaces:
 - a. Oakwood Park
 - b. Town Park
 - c. Tucker Park play area
 - d. Portwell Pump and Seat Area
 - e. All Saints closed churchyard
 - f. The Elms Tennis Court
 - g. The Wilderness
 - h. Clos Melois Boules Park
 - i. Town Council adopted bus shelters
 - j. Town Council adopted planters
 - k. Town Council adopted benches
- 8. The Committee will, in addition to the above responsibility, ensure that the children's play equipment located in Oakwood and Tucker Parks is maintained to a safe standard.
- 9. The Committee will ensure that the tools, machinery and vehicles available for staff use are insured and properly maintained.
- 10. The Committee will ensure all health and safety requirements are met.
- 11. The Committee will consider all matters referred to by the Council and, where appropriate, will recommend suitable courses of action on these
- 12. The Committee will consider any future proposals for the acquisition or disposal of open spaces and Venues within the parish of Great Faringdon and make recommendations to Council.
- 13. The committee has a duty to consider the long-term environmental impacts of its decisions and take steps to reduce FTC's carbon footprint and promote sustainability.
