### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14(1)

Notice of Temporary Traffic Order  
Faringdon-Ferndale Street / Skinners Lane  
Prohibition of Through Traffic and One Way Suspension  
Date of Order: 14 October 2024  
Coming into force: 21 October 2024

This Order is being introduced because of sewer repair works which are anticipated to be completed on 1 November 2024.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle proceeding in the section of Ferndale Street at its junction with Skinners Lane outside property number 21. Skinners Lane will temporarily become two way traffic to allow entrance and exit for residents during the closure.

Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via the signed diversion route.

The “*Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads, Faringdon) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1982*” as amended. will be temporarily suspended for Skinners Lane.

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
