# Grants Sub Committee 29th April 2024

The following Grants were awarded:

1. Faringdon Junior Youth Club were awarded £5,000 to operate a youth club in Faringdon.

2. Faringdon Games Club awarded cost of room hire

3. Live at the Park were awarded £1,200 to help fund the running costs of the event in June 2024.

4. Folly Fest 2024 were awarded £3,500 + £1200 room hire towards cost of FollyFest: 7th – 9th July.

5. Bangers and Beer Festival – were awarded cost of room hire.

6. **Enrych** – Applying for **£1,000**. A grant was **deferred** in order for Enrych to present more details explaining how Faringdon residents benefit from their work.

# Planning and Highways 20<sup>th</sup> May 2024

**Cllr. Rufus Lunn** was elected **Vice Chair** to support newly elected **Chair Cllr. Alan Ford**.

Five planning applications were considered with no objections registered.

The Vale of White Horse **deep clean** will come to Faringdon in **early July** members suggested locations in need of attention.

A new County Council (OCC) **Highways engagement team** is in place, FTC will request a meeting to discuss issues that have been raised and cause problems for residents.

The committee was disappointed to be informed that OCC **do not have the budget in 2024 to carry out proposed changes to Swan Lane traffic flow**. This would be monitored and raised again in 6 months.
